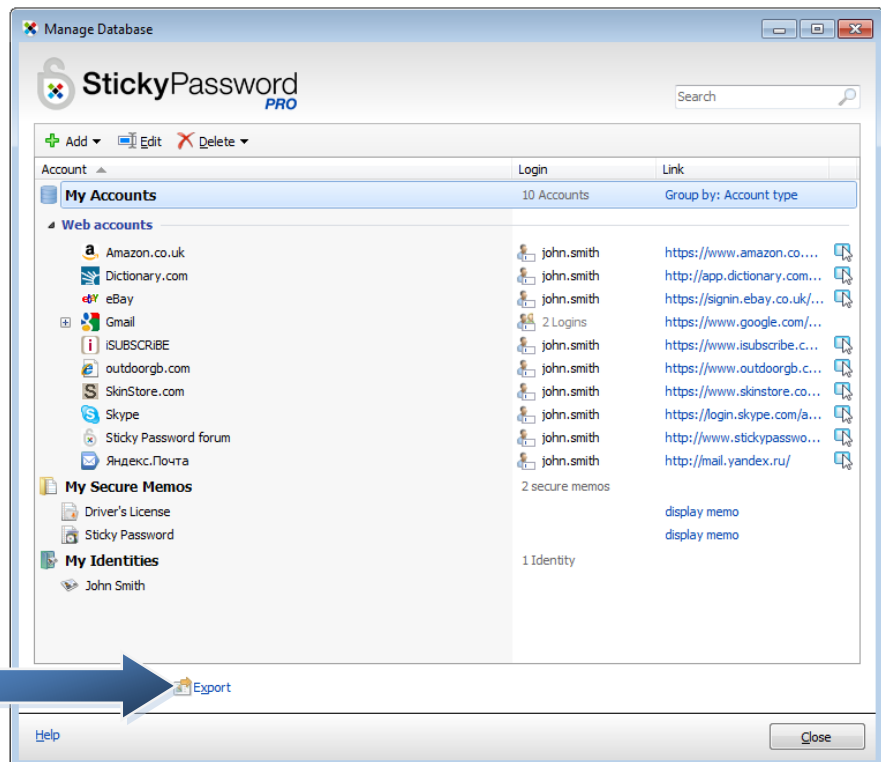


Start using Sticky Password on your iPhone

IMPORTANT

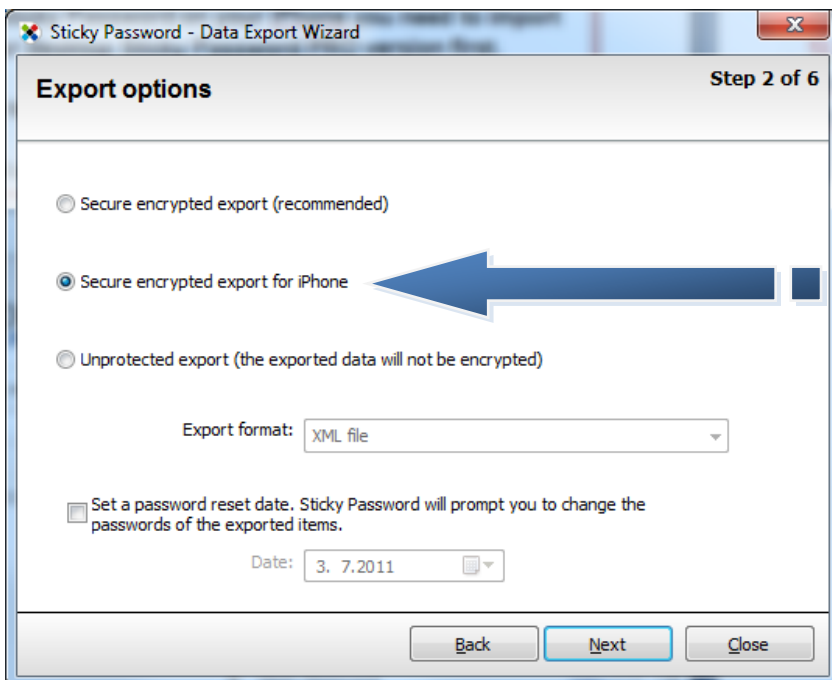
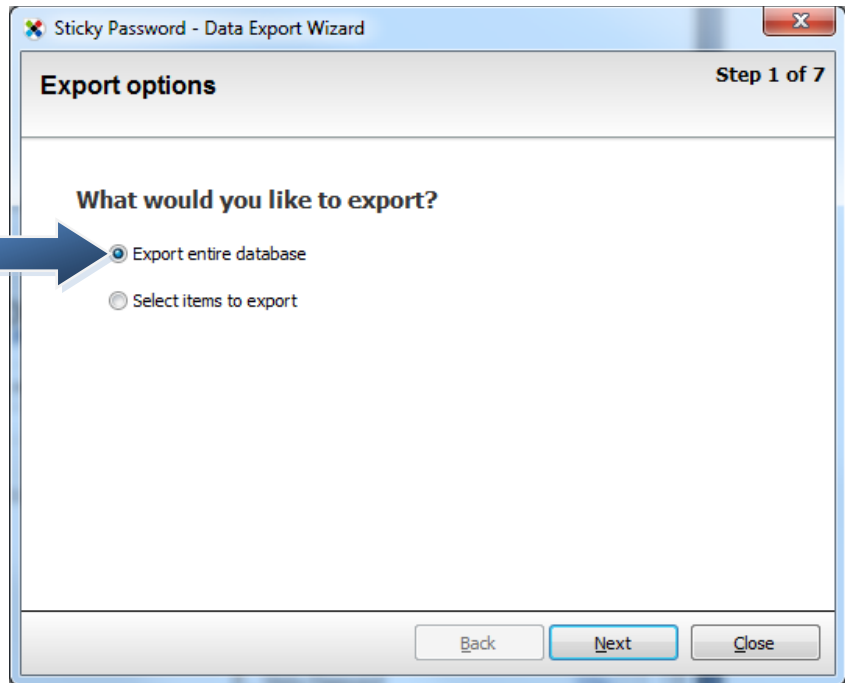
- In order to be able to use Sticky Password on your iPhone you need to import existing database from your desktop Sticky Password PRO version first.
- Currently it is not possible to use iPhone version as a stand-alone product.
- Sticky Password PRO 5.0.4 or higher is required.
- iOS 4 and higher are supported.

Export your database from your desktop Sticky Password



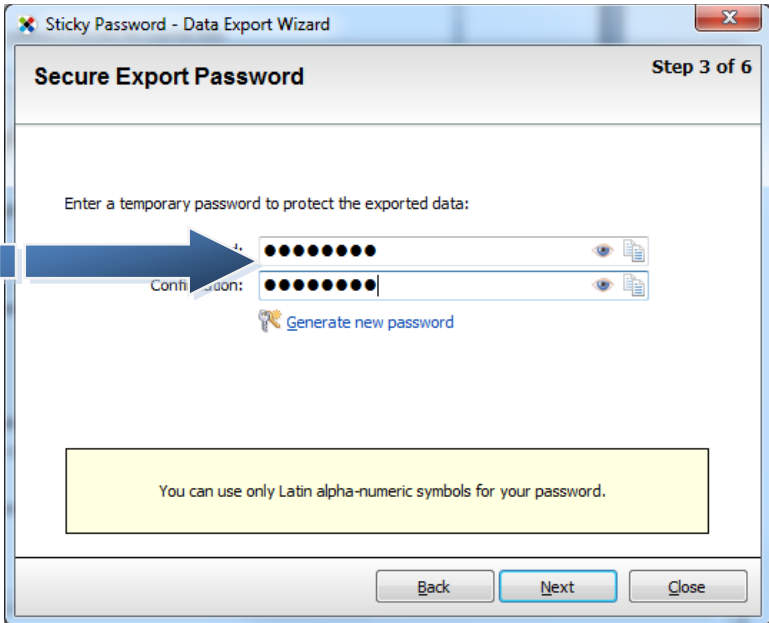
1) Open Manage Database dialog and click „Export“.

2) Select „Export entire database“ and click „Next“.



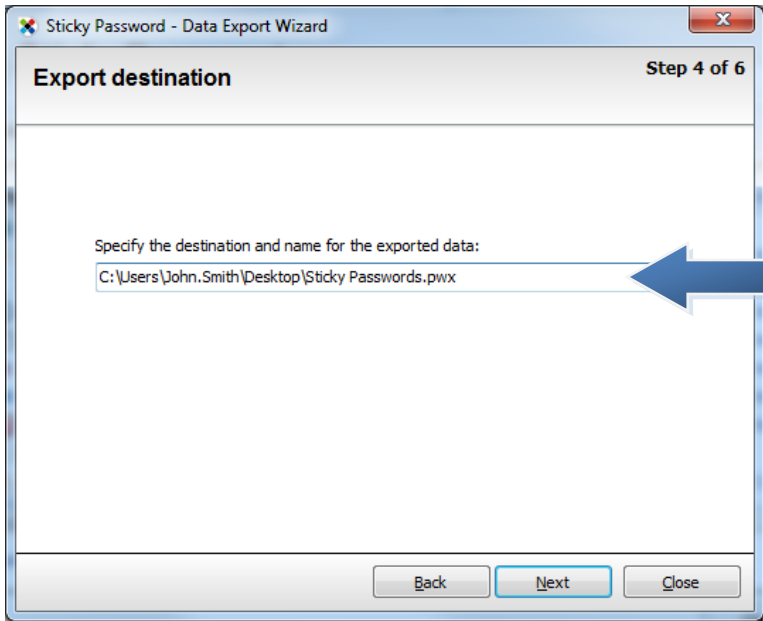
3) Select „Secure encrypted export for iPhone“ and click „Next“.

4) Define Master Password for your iPhone version and click „Next“.



IMPORTANT

Use only Latin alpha-numeric symbols for your password as your iPhone wouldn't accept any "special" characters.



5) Select destination for the exported file and click „Next“.

IMPORTANT

- Define a strong Master Password. It will protect your personal data on your iPhone.
- Remember your Master Password. You will need it to access your personal data on your iPhone.

Import your database into iTunes

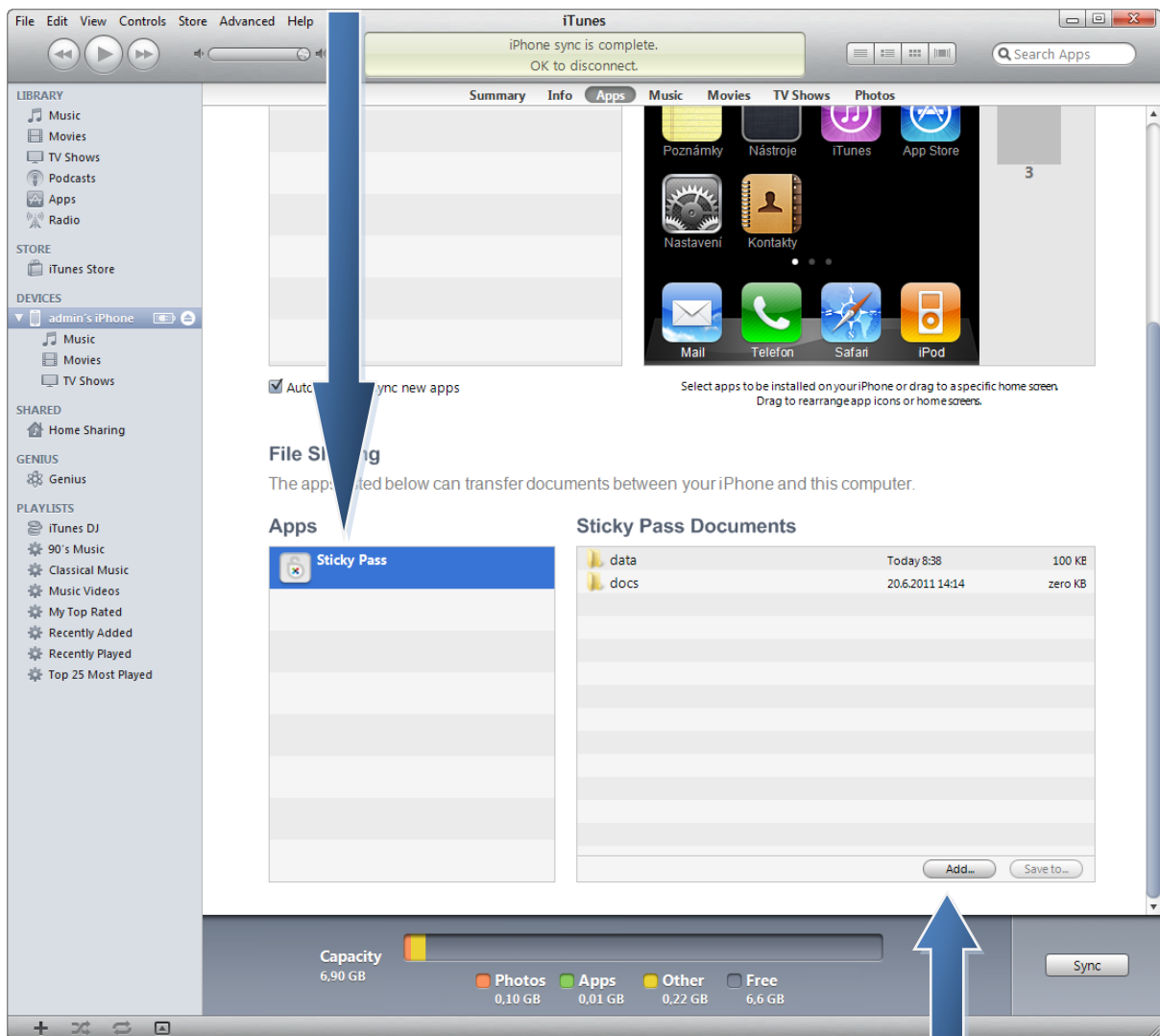
Connect your iPhone device to a computer with iTunes.

6) Open iTunes and select iPhone in the Devices list.

7) Click Apps at the top of the screen.



8) In the File Sharing section, select Sticky Pass.

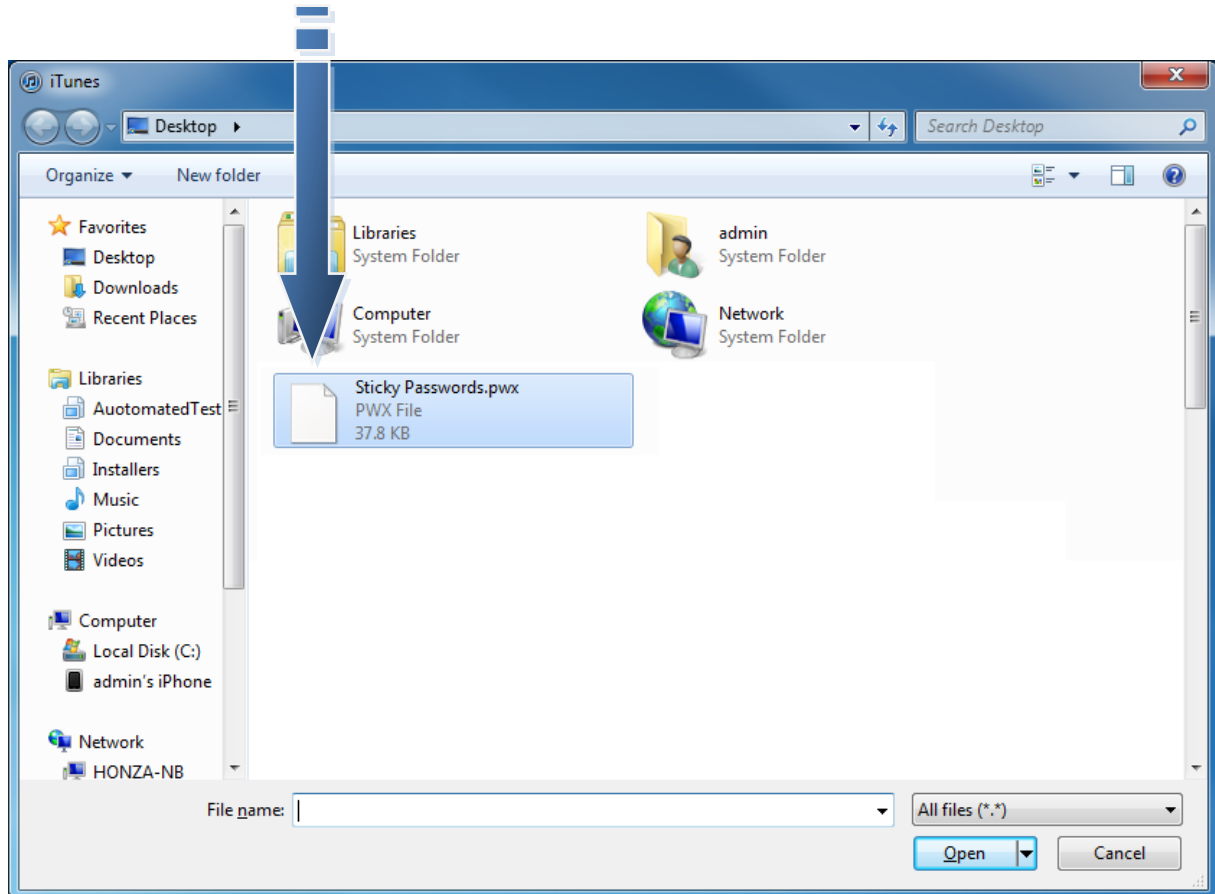


TIP

Alternatively to step 9) you can simply drag & drop your database to the Documents section.

9) Click "Add".

10) Select the exported database file and click “Open”.

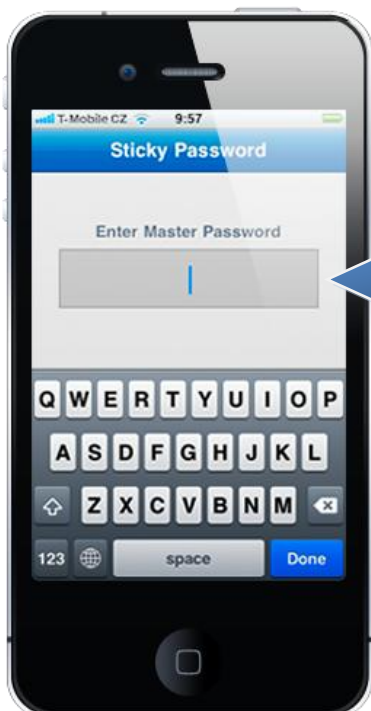


IMPORTANT

- Navigate to a location where you stored your database in step **5)** of this tutorial.
- Your iPhone database has pwx extension.

Launch Sticky Password on your iPhone

11) Select Sticky Password icon on your iPhone's desktop.



12) You will be prompted to enter your Master Password.

IMPORTANT

Please note that you need to enter the same Master Password as you defined in the step 4) of this tutorial.
